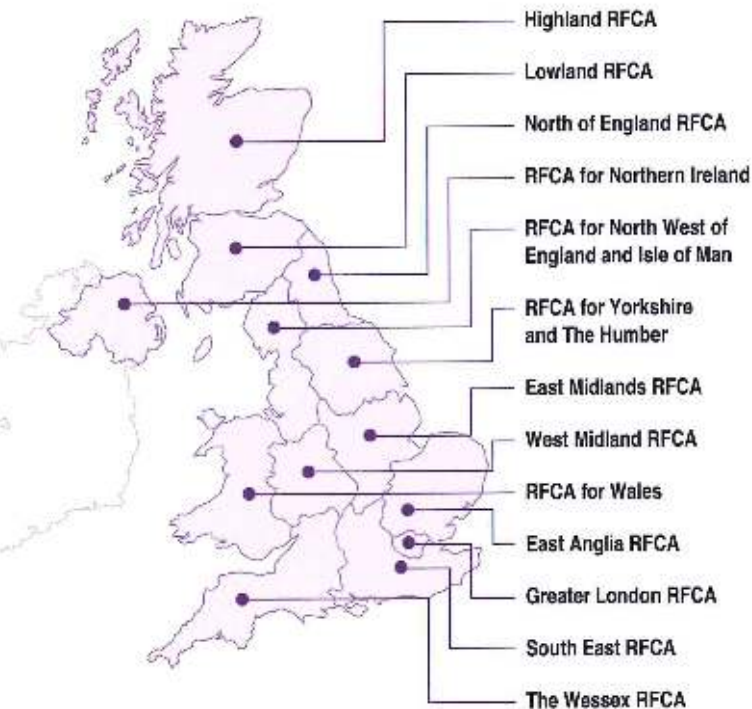
HIGHLAND RESERVE FORCES' AND CADETS' ASSOCIATION INTRODUCTION

1. Background and History. The UK has 13 Reserve Forces' and Cadets' Associations (RFCAs), with their boundaries as indicated on the map at Figure 1. Their origins lie in the reorganisation by Lord Haldane, Secretary of State for War, of the Territorial Force, codified in the Territorial and Reserve Forces Act 1907. The Act made the Regular Army responsible for command and training of the Territorial Force, but in acknowledgement of the importance of maintaining the support of the communities from which the Territorial Force was drawn, established Territorial Force Associations. The Associations subsequently evolved, gaining responsibility for the reserves of all three services, as well as the service cadet organisations, and in 2000 the then Territorial Army and Volunteer Reserve Associations became RFCAs to better reflect their role. Highland RFCA (HRFCA) is part of this proud and enduring tradition of support.

2. HRFCA Today. HRFCA today operates in an increasingly complex environment characterised by a range of factors. These include: the implementation of the expansion of the UK's strategic defence and her ability to project force as set out in SDSR 2015; the impact of these developments on the Reserve Forces in HRFCA's area of responsibility; the development of the Reserve Footprint itself; youth and cadet initiatives; changes in defence estate management; the establishment of the Defence Relationship Management (DRM) organisation; and continuing pressure on budgets. Concurrently HRFCA, in common with its counterparts across the UK, is restructuring itself to ensure optimal efficiency and effectiveness in supporting its customers and stakeholders; this work began in 2016 and is expected to take several years to complete.

3. Regional Context. These challenges are being addressed within the wider regional context of a nation with its own unique cultural, political and social characteristics, whose devolved government and administration dictate both that a different approach is adopted from elsewhere in the UK and that HRFCA works in the closest possible collaboration with Lowland RFCA in order to ensure the coherent and seamless delivery of business outputs. Geography is a significant additional factor, and HRFCA is the most dispersed of all the RFCAs. Road, rail, air and sea communications, together with remoteness of its furthest outposts, impose unique challenges of distance, time and space, and therefore of cost and complexity, in the delivery of services to the standard expected by its customers and stakeholders.

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

4. HRFCA's Key Characteristics.

- An 'Arm's Length Body' of Central Government, with Crown status and established by statute.
- A manifestation of the Volunteer ethos.
- A Volunteer membership which brings with it unparalleled expertise and breadth of experience.
- Tri-Service.
- Reflecting the region for which it is responsible.
- A not-for-profit organisation.
- Offering value for money.

5. HRFCA Values.

- To promote the interests of the Armed Forces and the Cadets.
- To champion the Volunteer ethos both within and outwith the Services.
- To be apolitical.
- Through a corporate approach, directed by the Council of RFCAs, to exercise collective responsibility, influence and recognition, while remaining independent (from the MoD and the chains of command) and autonomous (from other RFCAs).
- To support the work of third sector organisations which also contribute to the wellbeing of Service personnel and veterans.
- To supplement Government funding for our dependencies through our income generation.

6. HRFCA's Mission. Provide efficient and effective support to the Reserve Forces and Service Cadet Organisations within its area of responsibility, in order to allow stakeholders to deliver military capability, ensure estate compliance and fulfil the Cadet Organisations' requirements, including recruitment, employer and infrastructure support and regional representation, now and in the future.

7. Strategic Objectives. HRFCAs fulfil their mission through the achievement of the Strategic Objectives, derived from five Service Level Agreements (RN, Army, RAF, Defence Infrastructure Organisation and the Reserve Forces and Cadets branch of the MoD), set out in its Management Plan and summarised at Figure 2. Strategic Objectives (and Lead Responsibility)	
1.	To provide advice and assistance to MoD Stakeholders in relation to Reserves and Cadets, including the use of resources in areas relevant to Defence (Lead: All Depts).
2.	To maintain, sustain and develop cost-effective, fit for purpose Reserve and Cadet Estate, in line with Defence Strategy (Lead: Hd Est).
3.	To support Defence and the single Services' national, regional and local plans for the development and sustainment of the Firm Base and effective relationships between the Armed Forces and local communities (Community Engagement) (Lead: Hd Eng).
4.	To develop and sustain mutually-beneficial relationships between employers (and employer stakeholders) and the MoD on military personnel matters (Lead: Hd Eng).
5.	To provide support to the single Services on Reserve Recruitment as resourced (Lead: Hd Eng).
6.	To provide support to the Service Cadet Organisations as detailed in the single Service SLAs, and to assist with the wider development of youth initiatives (Lead: DCE).
7.	To operate within Government and Departmental restrictions and guidelines, ensuring value for money, compliance and regularity in all areas (Lead: Hd Fin/BM, all Resource Managers).

8. These Objectives translate into the following main functions and raison d'être of the Association:

- Contributing to the well-being of the Volunteer Reserve Forces and Service Cadet Organisations.
- Liaison with the civilian community, in particular with local employers in both the public and private sectors.
- Recruiting support for the Reserve Forces and Army Cadet Force.
- The fostering of close and continuous co-operation between the Regular and Reserve Forces and the Cadets.
- The provision and maintenance of accommodation for the Army Reserve, Royal Naval Reserve/Royal Marines Reserve (RNR/RMR), Army Cadet Force, Air Training Corps, and Combined Cadet Force.
- The administration of the Army Cadet Force in conjunction with HQ 51 Infantry Brigade.

CONSTITUTION AND MEMBERSHIP

9. Constitution. HRFCA is a statutory autonomous body, established by Parliament within the terms of the Reserve Forces Act 1996. It has its own Scheme of Association – in effect its licence to operate – drawn up by the Defence Council. More detail on the Scheme of Association is available via the Members Area of the HRFCA website at www.hrfca.co.uk.

10. Membership Structure. HRFCA is structured to have a President and Vice-Presidents who are Lord-Lieutenants, an Executive Board drawn from the Association's full membership (of up to 220 members in accordance with the Scheme of Association), and an unspecified number of associate members. The membership is a key resource available to assist HRFCA in achieving its Mission and Strategic Objectives. HRFCA's membership should be as diverse and broad as possible, in order to best discharge the roles set out below.

11. Members' Role. Through its four Area Committees, the membership enhances HRFCA's networking capabilities by:

- Engaging with the civil community to foster interaction between them, the Armed Forces and the Service Cadet Organisations.
- Maintaining an awareness of current Defence-related issues, the Armed Forces and the Service Cadet Organisations.
- Acting as ambassadors in the community, providing a two-way conduit for undertaking specific tasks and to report relevant Reserve and Cadet-related issues back to HRFCA for subsequent transmission to the Chain of Command.
- Helping to maintain and develop HRFCA's network.
- Supporting with relevant expertise the Association's outputs, including in respect of: Estate and Facilities Management; Community, Civil and Employer Engagement; Employer Support; Recruiting Support; and Cadets and Youth.

- Promoting, fostering and supporting the recruitment, retention and wellbeing of the Reserve Forces and Service Cadet Organisations, and sustaining close and continuous cooperation between the Regular Forces, Reserve Forces and Cadets.
- Access into communities not previously well-connected with, or disposed towards, the Armed Forces or Service Cadet Organisations.

12. Membership Categories. The following categories of full and associate membership make up the HRFCA membership:

- **Ex-Officio Members** who include:
 - Lord-Lieutenants (President/Vice Presidents of Highland RFCA) – non-voting.
 - Reserve Forces Commanding Officers of major units.
 - Reserve Forces Officers Commanding of sub-units.
 - SCC Representatives, ACF Commandants, ATC Wing Commanders and CCF Contingent Commanders.
- **Selected Naval, Military or Air Force Members** who are either serving or retired from the Regular, Reserve or Volunteer Reserve Forces, together with representatives of the Service Cadet Organisations.
- **Representative Members** who may be drawn from the widest range of backgrounds but should include: Local Authority Councillors, Employers (including all those that serve on the REEG in their Area), Youth Organisations, representation from Further and Higher Education and teachers.
- **Co-opted Members** who may be additional serving Regular or Reserve Officers or Regimental Secretaries, who bring particular benefits to the Association.
- **Invited Members** that include COs of units whose HQs are not based in HRFCA's area, senior Regional appointment holders in the Regular, Volunteer Reserve and Cadet Forces (notably SCC and ATC) – non-voting.
- **Associate Members** to include Honorary appointments holders to Reserve and Cadet units, and selected former members, together with others who may benefit from the Association's purposes – non-voting.

13. President and Vice-Presidents. Our President is always one of the Lord-Lieutenants from the Highland RFCA Area, with the remaining Lord-Lieutenants acting as Vice Presidents. They are non-voting Members.

14. The HRFCA Executive Board. The Executive Board is elected annually at the Annual Association Meeting from the Association membership and is responsible for ensuring the smooth running of the Association. All matters relating to the exercise of Association powers are vested by the membership in the Highland RFCA Executive Board by resolution at the

Annual Association Meeting. The Executive Board meets formally four times each year and otherwise as required.

15. The Policy Committee. The Policy Committee of the Association Board consists of the Chairman, Service Vice-Chairmen and the Highland REEG Chairman. This Committee meets on an ad hoc basis to address major policy issues outside the formal round of Board Meetings. Much of its work is done out of committee.

16. Area Committees. Highland RFCA membership is sub-divided into four Area Committees. Office Bearers of the Area Committees include a Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Representative. The appointment of the Area Chairmen (as Vice-Chairmen of Highland RFCA) will be done in close consultation with the Highland RFCA Executive Board; on occasions it may be necessary to nominate outside candidates. In each Area one meeting is held in a year, in the autumn, taking place in Inverness (N), Aberdeen (NE), Dundee/Perth (E) and Dumbarton/Stirling (S). The Area Committees cover the following Lieutenancies:

● **Northern**

Caithness, Inverness-shire, Moray, Nairnshire, The Orkney Islands, Ross & Cromarty, Sutherland and The Western Isles.

● **North-Eastern**

Aberdeenshire, Banffshire, City of Aberdeen, Kincardineshire and the Shetland Islands.

● **Eastern**

Angus, City of Dundee, Fife and Perthshire & Kinross-shire.

● **Southern**

Argyll & Bute, Clackmannanshire, Dunbartonshire, Stirlingshire & Falkirk and the northern part of Lanarkshire.

17. The HRFCAs Council. The Council meets twice a year in May and November and consists of the Executive Board plus the stakeholder representation from Naval Regional Commander Scotland and Northern Ireland; Area Officer Sea Cadets Corps; Commander 51 Infantry Brigade; Colonel Cadets HQ 51 Infantry Brigade; Air Officer Scotland; Regional Commandant Air Training Corps Scotland and Northern Ireland, together with Vice Chairmen HRFCAs Area Committees or Area Representative Members if neither the Chair or Vice Chair are able to attend.

18. Membership Selection. Area Committee Chairs, supported by the Executive, are responsible for identifying and selecting members of their Area Committees within the guidelines of the Scheme of Association. The aim is to attract members who are current within their field of expertise and who are prepared to promote the values and engage in the activities of the Association. The expected commitment to the Association is for a period not exceeding 5 years. All members, apart from those who are ex-officio, may serve up to the maximum age of 70. On retirement as a member, individuals may be invited to become Associate members.

19. Office Bearers' Term of Office. An Office Bearer's Term of Office is for one year but may be extended annually up to a maximum of five years. Nominations for the posts of Office Bearers will be addressed at each Autumn Area Meeting. Endorsement of nominated candidates will take place at the Highland RFCA Executive Board Meeting held each February, followed by formal election at the Annual Association Meeting in March.

20. HRFCA Permanent Staff. The Association and Executive Board are supported by a permanent staff of crown servants. The staff are led by a Chief Executive and Deputy Chief Executive at the Association Headquarters in Dundee, with other staff located in Inverness, Dumbarton and Aberdeen.

21. Cadet Force Permanent Support Staff. Permanent support staff are employed by HRFCA to provide assistance to the five Army Cadet Force Battalions and two Independent Batteries within the Association's area, and Air Training Corps Wing Support staff for certain areas.

22. Finance. HRFCA is funded via the Council of RFCAs by the following stakeholders:

- MoD Reserve Forces and Cadets (RF&C)
- Navy Command HQ
- Army HQ
- Air Command HQ
- Defence Infrastructure Organisation (DIO)

In addition, Highland RFCA receives income from two further sources: Non-Domestic Rates (NDR) rebate on cadet properties; and Regionally-Generated Income (RGI) from rental and letting income, and bank interest. Under the direction of the Executive Board, this is reinvested into developing the HRFCA estate, Community Engagement, the disbursement of welfare grants to units, and in other priorities determined by the Board in support of the Association's Mission.

23. Financial Reporting and Audit. Accounts are produced on an accruals basis and follow, as far as appropriate, UK private sector practice. HRFCA's accounts are independently audited annually before being passed for consolidation by the Council of RFCAs. They are then subject to National Audit Office scrutiny and are periodically subject to examination by the Defence Internal Audit organisation.

ADVOCACY AND ENGAGEMENT MESSAGES

24. Enduring Key Messages for Members. In order to assist members in their important advocacy role, a range of enduring 'key messages' have been developed. The table at Figure 3 sets out these messages, together with the 'target audiences' for which they are intended. Human interaction not being an exact science, neither the messages themselves nor the audiences are intended to be prescriptive, but reference to them may assist members in informal conversations as well as in more formal discussions.

25. Time-sensitive Messaging. In addition to the enduring key messages, responsive messaging to reflect recent or short-term issues will be posted periodically into the Members Area of the HRFCA website when appropriate.

26. Engagement Strategy. The HRFCA Engagement Strategy, which covers key messages, target audiences and the ends, ways and means through which engagement contributes to the achievement of HRFCA's Strategic Objectives, is also accessible to members via the website at www.hrfca.co.uk.

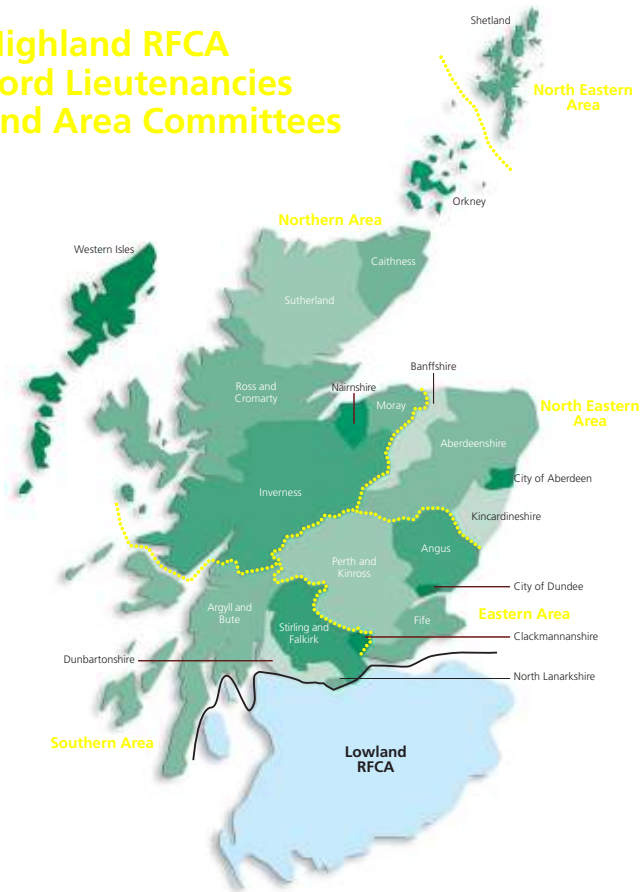
